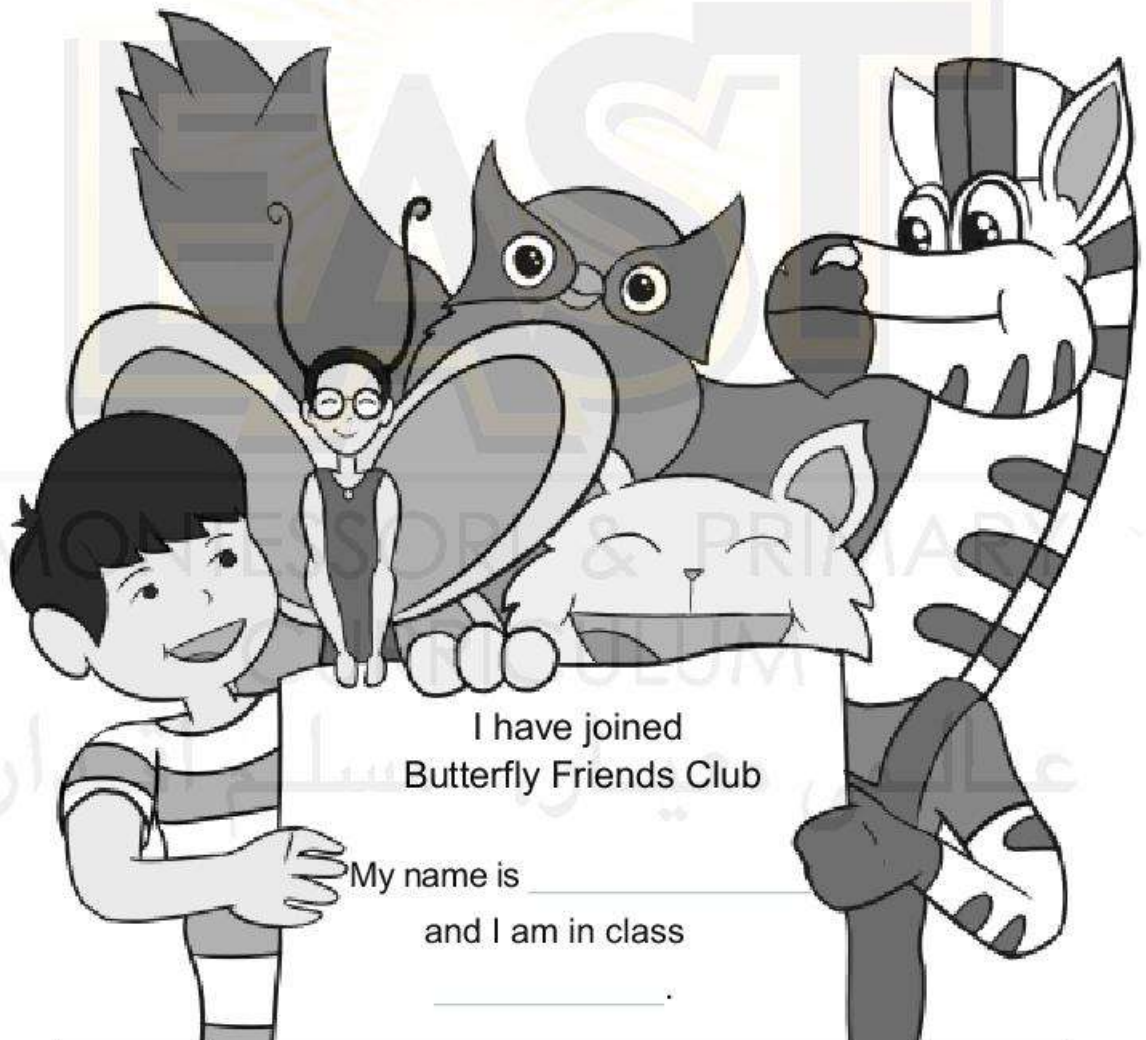






## Handwriting Series Pre Year 2

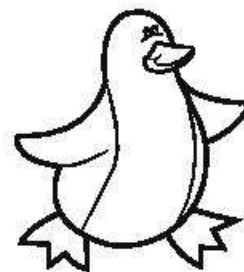

**Instructions:** Ask children to follow the direction of arrows and draw a line.





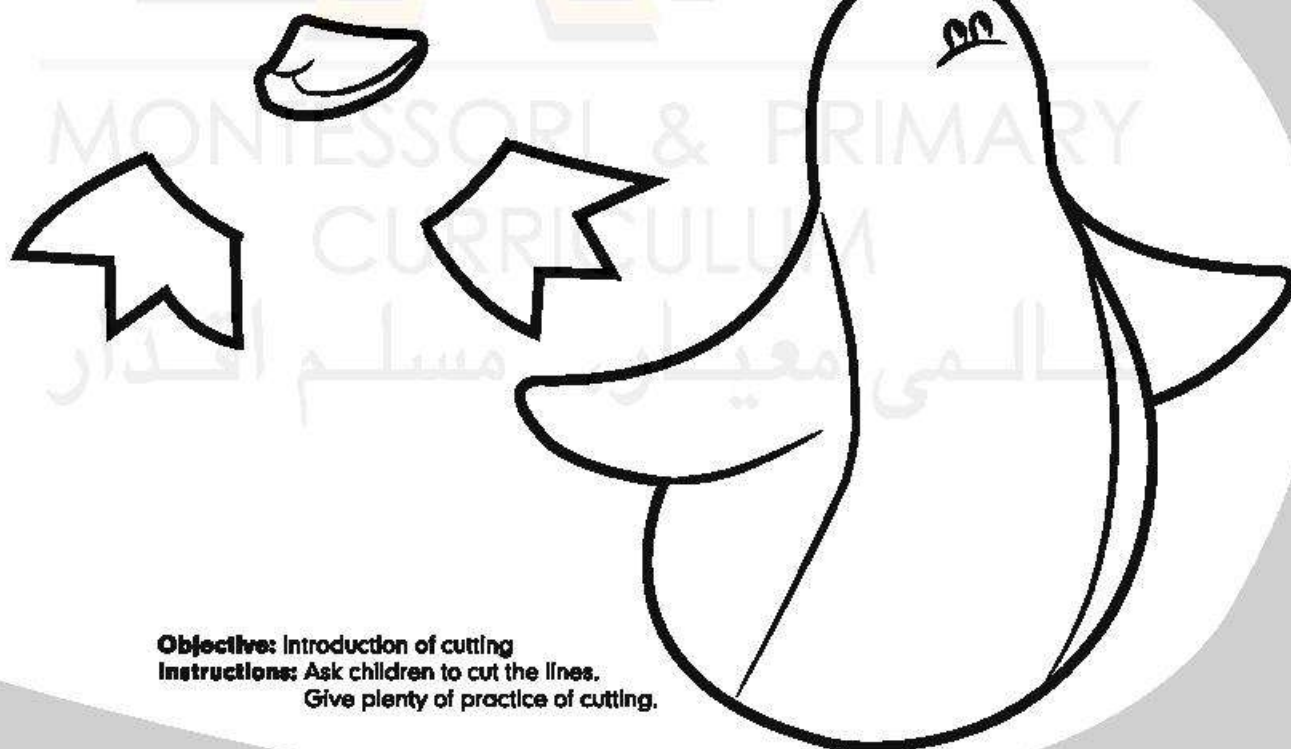

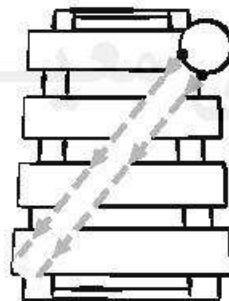
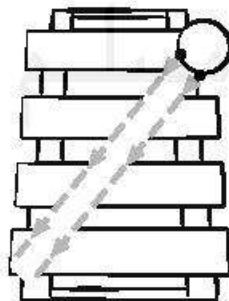
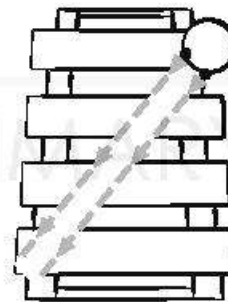
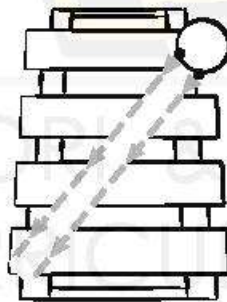
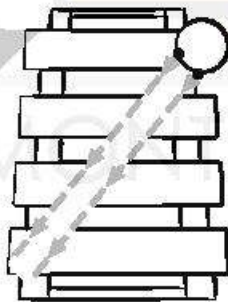
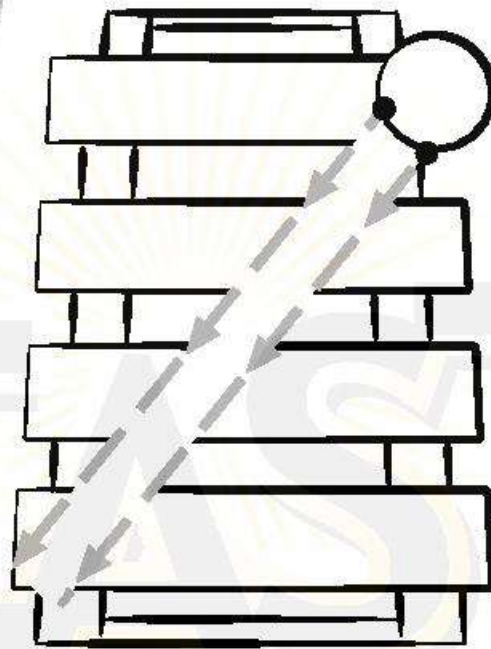


**Objective:** Introduction of anti-clockwise movement

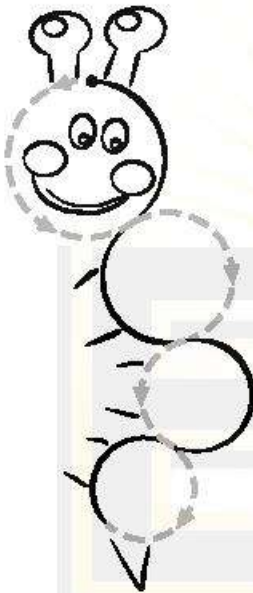
**Objective:** Introduction of diagonal lines
