




Handwriting Series Pre Year 3






Objective: Practice of cutting Instructions: Ask children to cut the pieces of picture and paste them in order to make a complete picture.




Objective: Awareness of grass letters. **Instructions:** Give plenty of practice on board before introducing this page.



Objective: Practice of a pattern of anti-clockwise and clockwise movements **Instructions:** Ask children to trace and draw the movement properly.



Instructions: Ask children to identify and circle the letters which are not written in the proper space and then, ask to write them correctly.




Objective: Practice of special letters



Instructions: Ask children to use pencil tip or any thin strip of paper to manage spaces between the letters in a word.



Objective: Practice of letter writting in sentences Instructions: Tell children this special sentence contains all alphabets. Then ask them to copy the sentence on the next page.



Objective: To manage space between the words in a sentence **Instructions:** Ask children to give one finger space between the words in a sentence.


Objective: Use of capital letter and full stop
