a) Alex is a wonderful player.



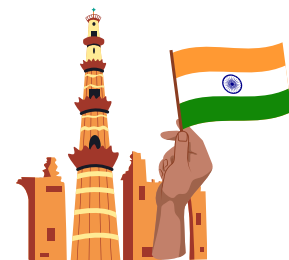

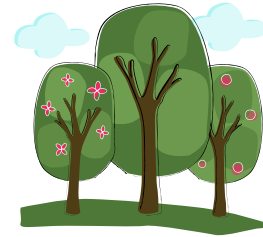
# COMMON NOUNS

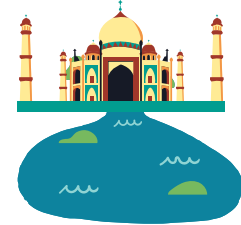
