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COMMON AND PROPER NOUNS

Common noun: A common noun names any person/ place /thing animal in general/ or in common. A common nouns represents noun of the same kind/class.

Example: boy, state, desk, bird.

Proper noun: It is the name of a specific/ particular, person/place/thing /animal. A proper noun always begins with a capital letter.

Example: Mary, Boston, May, Snoopy.

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COMMON AND PROPER NOUNS

Common noun: A common noun names any person/ place/ thing/ animal in general/or in common. A common nouns represents noun of the same kind/class.

Proper noun: It is the name of a specific / particular, person / place / thing / animal.

A proper noun always begins with a capital letter.
